#1) Brent welcomed everyone and began the meeting.

#2) Jessica addressed the Public Safety Expo. She and Dominica do not feel that we should try for spring because of the costs of the vendors put out already attempting to have the fall expo. She stated that maybe Instructors could do some smaller activities: classroom visits or those who are actively hiring can come and do a table in quad. Jessica may take the shirts to the agencies that came to the expo. Jessica also said that next year we need to have a plan B in place (classrooms, hallways, indoor theater)

#5) Brent preparing for High School visits in spring. He visited Delano High School and Shafter. Went to Wasco High but ended up visiting with them at the Weill. Wasco does have a PST program. They want to add Fire B1 & EMR class. Pat Smith already teaching CRIM B1 at Wasco. We will need to find a college Instructor to teach the new additions. They had 45 students graduate with an AA before their HS graduation!

#6) Victoria shared Financial Aid information; Bookstore can give advance on FA for books, as long as student has completed a FAFSA. She will email spring dates for advancements. FAFSA opened up Oct 1 – Students should do it now. She also talked about Finish in 4 programs. They have to sign up for that, there's a link on web page.

#7) Mary Jo talked about the April 8th Active Shooter Drill that will take place on BC's campus. Big event, bringing in people County wide. Bringing in 50 students along with BC's classified to take part.
