Nick led the ISIT charge review: ISIT serves as a recommending body to the President of the College. We gather data from the ISIT Unit Plan update to make recommendations and we Prioritize technology needs on the campus. We assess the use of technology and assist the campus with innovation.

Introduction of new members to the committee. Welcome everyone.

Jenny Peters asked "What is a MOOC?" Massive Open Online Courses – Table until Bill Moseley can be part of the discussion – Bill was ill and not able to attend this meeting. Bill has been .4 reassigned to be the Interim Faculty Director of Technology, Innovation and Professional Development. Bill will be hosting some brown bag lunch sessions on technology – specifically online. He is working to develop an online orientation for online students. Currently no one walks an online student into their class with support like we do our face-to-face students. Tutoring and Counseling as well as orientation are part of this as well. Student Services is involved. Faculty teaching online also had a bootcamp offered by Bill this past summer to attend that was successful.

Internet attacks on BanWeb – 40,000 computers hitting Banweb at one time. Re-routing through a cloud provider. 40,000 people were trying to hit at one time and saturated the firewall – Todd explained further. CENIC our internet provider shut us down. North Orange College had a similar attack. There are theories at the DO as to how/why this happened.

ISIT College-wide report: Action Plan is to bring back to committee the ISIT Unit Plans from the Annual Update process with Program Review. Hopefully this can start to happen in October. Safely in November.
