- II. **Health & Wellness Center:** Upcoming Health Fair on BC campus, multiple agencies coming on too BC campus from 8am-2pm. Offering free rapid HIV Testing collaborated with Clinic of Sierra Vista, BC nursing student will also have a booth free glucose, body mass, blood pressure testing. Currently DPS are spending over \$10,000 a month on overtime. Safety Officers are burning out quick. We are backfilling 2 positions. But we need an additional 4 full-time officers.
  - b. **Dispatcher Position** – Emergency phone lines are being answered by student worker. But DPS would like to hire an actual Emergency Dispatcher due to level of stress and maturity needed for this position.
  - c. **Cadets:** Are student worker, in uniforms currently help assist with student escort to their cars, and campus surveillance during all year around
  - d. **M&O Lighting Replacement inside building:** Have been going on replaced in all building.
  - e. Fresno Pacific- Southwest Campus will be solely BC campus only, will exceed Delano Campus population.
- III. **GET BUS:** (in the future) will be offering non-stop transportation from the Southwest Campus to BC Main campus; Then BC Main Campus to CSUB.
